The EDPA Foundation Scholarship program is designed to give back to the local tradeshow community through college-level educational scholarships for children who's parents are involved within the industry.

With the successful launch of this program four years ago, we are again asking for industry support through sponsorships and participation. The proof of our success has been in awarding of seven scholarships thus far and our goal is to award at least two new scholarships each year.

- Flag** – Logo on one flag (located at each hole).

This 7:30 am shotgun start will have foursomes playing in a Best-Ball format. Players can choose to create their own teams as trophies will be given out at the awards luncheon immediately following the tournament. The early afternoon lunch will have a deluxe menu with open-grilled items. A host of prizes will be raffled off and awarded by random selection during the tournament as well as during the meal.

The donation includes greens fees, golf cart and awards banquet. Trophies will be awarded for best score, longest drive, closest to the pin and other competitions. Rental clubs are available upon request.

Raffle tickets and Mulligan tickets will be sold at the registration table.

As offered in past years, we will offer a meal and awards only ticket for \$45.00 that will allow non-golfers to participate in the festivities.
